

Good Afternoon,

I hope this communication finds you all healthy and well. I wanted to remind students to get their assigned work from the weeks of March 16th through April 6th completed by April 6th. If you are able to take a photo or send completed work to your teachers through Schoology, Google Classroom, or your teachers' email, please do so by April 6th. If you are not able to send it electronically, the MS/HS will be having a homework/assignment drop off day on Monday, April 6th from 9:00 am – 7:00 pm. Bins with teacher's names will be set up at the East Parking lot (located off of Chestnut Street). Parents can drive up and drop off work.

Moving forward through 4th quarter, teachers will be reaching out and contacting students through their school email or by calling parents/guardians of their students. Instructions from each teacher about assigned work due dates, and times teachers have set for office hours and class activities will be communicated by the students' teachers. Students are reminded to check their school emails often. If you are in a location where internet is not available, your teachers will have alternative assignments made available to you through the mail delivery system or other arrangements to accommodate for the lack of internet services. Parents, please contact your child's teachers or me (at school) if you have any specific concerns.

Please keep in mind our 4th quarter will be very different than it normally would be. Teachers have been asked to follow recommended guidelines for online learning (which for grades 7-12 is no more than 3 hrs. per day). Know that your child's teachers and I care deeply about them and are not trying to make this a stressful learning experience. As we move forward in this journey together, please feel free to contact the teachers or myself with questions or concerns.
